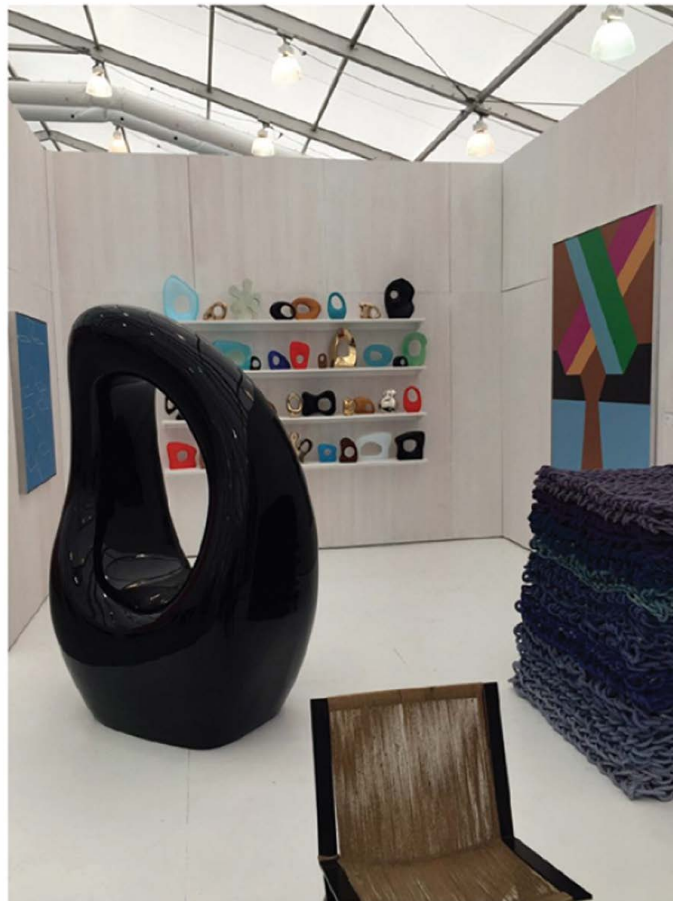

The 8 Unmissable Booths at UNTITLED Miami Beach

From paintings to a radio broadcasting pavilion, here's what to see.

If you want to take advantage of both the beach and the art that's all over Miami right now, you couldn't do much better than to visit UNTITLED, which takes place in a tent right on the sand at Ocean Drive and 12th Street. Here are some of the works and booths you shouldn't miss this year.

7. Mia Fonnagrives-Solow and Miriam Schapiro at Eric Firestone Gallery

Fonnagrives makes enticing abstract sculptures in materials like bronze, Lucite, and wood, and they go for anywhere from \$3,000 to \$80,000. On the other end of the booth, gorgeous abstract canvases by Miriam Schapiro are tagged at between \$100,000 and \$275,000, and date from 1967 to 1975.
